Get an Instrument

STEP I: See Your Instrument

STEP 2: Choose an Option Below

Rent-to-Own an Instrument

Use this option to participate in Marshall Music's rent-to-own program. Ms. Micheel and Ms. Nietupski highly recommend this option because it includes free instrument repairs and provides maximum flexibility should your child need to switch instruments in the future.

- I. Go to www.marshallmusic.com or call 800.221.1755.
- 2. Click Rent Now in the upper left hand corner.
- 3. Select Start Band Rental at the bottom.
- 4. Complete the steps.

The instrument will be delivered to school next fall, at which time your monthly payments will begin. You may purchase a folding music stand for your child to use at home. Ms. Micheel and Ms. Nietupski will help you purchase additional supplies {like reeds and cleaning materials} next fall.

Purchase a Used Instrument

Use this option to locate and repair a used instrument. This may not be the most cost-effective option as instrument repairs can be expensive.

Repair an Instrument
